## Abducted girl child in Ghatkesar is safe

## Delighted to hand over the abducted girl to family members

## Safety of women and children is our top priority: CP DS Chauhan IPS

The four-year-old Krishnaveni, who was kidnapped in Ghatkesar last night, was safely handed over to her parents by the Rachakonda police. Rachakonda Commissioner DS Chauhan himself picked up the baby and handed it over to the parents.

Suresh, who lives near the victim's house, abducted the child yesterday night around eight o'clock while she was out for chocolate. After receiving the complaint, Ghatkesar police immediately responded and started search operations through special teams. The accused who abducted the child was arrested at Secunderabad railway station. Later, the child was rescued and brought safely to her parents.

On this occasion, the commissioner said that the police was alerted immediately after receiving the complaint of child kidnapping, special teams were formed and search operations were carried out. All the CCTV cameras in the vicinity were checked and the movements of Suresh who abducted the baby were noticed. It is said that Suresh was taken into custody at the Secunderabad railway station as he was roaming suspiciously in the course of checking in teams, and after the accused was taken to the station along with the baby, the child's parents were informed and handed over to them safely. He said that the accused has been detained and is being investigated.

The commissioner said that whatever crime is committed within the jurisdiction of the commissionerate, the accused will be caught within 24 hours and we are working with determination to control the crimes. The victims thanked the police for bringing their child to them within hours. It is noteworthy that the Rachakonda Police Commissioner, who brought the baby safely to the mother's side, raised slogans of the locals saying, "Zindabad". The commissioner appreciated the Ghatkesar police for rescuing the girl.
