320 CCTV CAMERAS INAUGURATED IN MAHESHWARAM POLICE STATION LIMITS, MAHESHWARAM ZONE

Today, Sri G. Sudheer Babu, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Rachakonda, inaugurated 328 CCTV cameras across the Maheshwaram Police station limits of Maheshwaram Zone. Of these, 328 Community CCTV cameras have been installed in BTR Mak projects, Thummaloor, covering major roads and junctions, at a cost of Rs. 1.5 Crore (One Crore Fifty Lakhs) under a community initiative and has been successfully executed by REDFENCE AUOMATION.

Out of which 284 cameras are of 6 MP resolution, 90 m IR distance bullet cameras and 34 numbers of voice enabled indoor day and night colour dome cameras and 2 numbers of PTZ cameras with day and night capturing capability and 8 numbers of automatic number plates and gives automatic access to Boom Barrier for authorized vehicle only and the cameras are equipped with analytics like human detection, vehicle detection and face capturing capabilities and the storage capacity for the above cameras is for about 60 days.

These cameras will be integrated with the Command and Control Centre, where a dedicated team will monitor them 24/7 and a total CCTV Cameras geotagged within the Maheshwaram Zone.

Speaking on the occasion, Sri G. Sudheer Babu, IPS, highlighted the crucial role of CCTV surveillance in enhancing public safety and crime prevention. He stated that CCTV cameras are instrumental in deterring criminal activities, assisting in investigations, enabling proactive policing, aiding in crime analysis, and promoting a secure environment. He emphasized that CCTV surveillance is a vital component of modern crime prevention strategies and noted that the Rachakonda Police have successfully solved several sensational cases with the help of CCTV footage.

The Commissioner also appealed to colony and community elders to come forward and take the initiative to install CCTV cameras in their communities. He stressed that such efforts significantly contribute to public safety by deterring crime, monitoring suspicious activity, and assisting the police in investigations. The mere
